Subject: Service Road Q Closure and New Crossing of Taxiway S

On Monday, June 28, 2010 at 0600L as part of the Bradley West Improvement Project Service Road Q between the TBIT South Bus Gates and Taxiway C will be closed. A new route has been established for vehicles needing access the TBIT Southern Bus Gates and Delivery Docks.

The new route will cross Taxiway S just south of Security Post 5. Vehicles crossing the taxiway will be controlled by flagman. This crossing shall remain open 7 days a week and 24 hours a day.

Delivery and Authorized Vehicles only will be allowed to use this crossing. Construction activities will be increasing in the area of the North Bus Gates.

As always continue to use caution when crossing all aircraft movement areas and to not stop vehicles within zipper markings when crossing taxiways.
